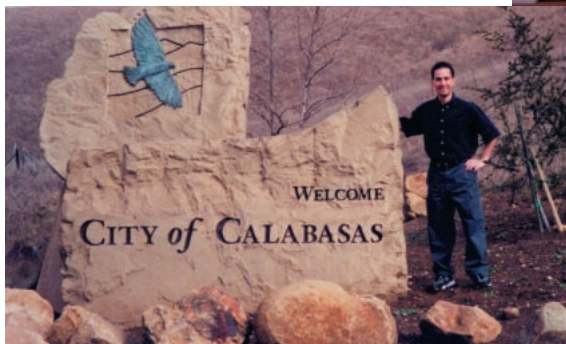

Since my election to the Calabasas City Council in 1997, I have been proud to participate in our city's many successful ventures. Consider that in the last eight years alone the City Council has:

- Acquired several parks and recreational facilities, including the Agoura Hills/Calabasas Community Center, Calabasas Creekside Park, Wild Walnut Park, Highlands Park, Gates Canyon Park, and the Calabasas Bark Park
- Worked cooperatively with community leaders to bring attractive private enterprises to Calabasas, such as The Commons in Calabasas Park and Creekside Village in Lost Hills.
- Established the Calabasas Municipal Library and secured an \$8.2 million state grant for the construction of a new library building
- Balanced the city's budget every year with an impressive reserve fund of more than \$15 million
- Defeated the proposed Ahmanson Ranch development
